

# Poster Guidelines

## NEW TO OR 2019 CONFERENCE

### *Content Requirements:*

- Title
- Authors and collaborators. Who is doing it? Are there any collaborators
- Aim and objectives, or research question, or hypotheses. What is being done?
- Background, mapping on to theory or practice. Why is it being done?
- Methods. How is it being done?
- Results and conclusions to date. What is the expected contribution to knowledge or an organisation?

### *Size Requirements*

- Posters should be A1 or A0 in size (**note each board is two metres high by one metre wide; please use portrait orientation for A0 posters**);
- Authors should select a text size and pictures/charts that are readable for a distance of 3 feet. (see help on producing conference posters below)

### *Author responsibilities*

- Bring a printed copy of the poster(s) and poster fasteners (such as Velcro).

### *Guide for one minute presentation*

1. Poster authors must provide a one minute overview of their project or research.
2. The suggested format is to briefly outline:
  - a. the background to the project or research
  - b. challenges or methodology
  - c. impact or key results
